
The Seussification of Romeo and Juliet **Mead School Play Rules and Permission**

Our Spring play this year will be The Seussification of Romeo and Juliet by Peter Bloedel. Being in a play is a big responsibility. Each person depends on everyone else to do their jobs – actors and crew! This is why we must insist on the following:

- 1. It is important that you attend **both** audition dates.
- In order to be in the school play, you cannot be involved in a sport. The play must be your priority!
- You cannot be taking a trip during the period of rehearsal. That is not fair to the other actors.
- It is especially important that you will be available every day of the week starting 2/28!
- 5. You must memorize your lines over winter break! You must be off script by MLK Day 1/17!
- 6. You must commit to being at ALL performances AND the Saturday Dress Rehearsal!
- 7. There will be an information meeting about Drama Club and a chance to pick monologues for auditions on Monday, November 22nd.

- 4. If you want to be on <u>stage crew</u>, you must commit to being at ALL performances AND the Saturday Dress Rehearsal on 3/5!

- 6. Attend the first read through on Monday, December 13th.
